I study the politics of transnational communication infrastructures, from telegraphy and the internet to submarine cables, 5G, and satellite networks, working both inside and outside the institutions that govern them. Long-term participation at the IETF, ICANN, and 3GPP, combined with computational analysis and archival work, lets me trace how standards, sanctions, and industrial policy materially shape who gets connected, on what terms, and to whose benefit.
